Tipping is essentially a customary way of saying thank you for a good Job ideally tipping will be done after finishing your Kilimanjaro trek this can be one confusing part of your tour without proper guideline, One may end up not sure of how much and who really should be handed over the tips.

Who Should you tip?

Kilimanjaro treks are accompanied by support crew who are allocated to different tusks throughout the expedition, both young and old these ladies and gentlemen most of whom hail from the foothills of Mt Kilimanjaro have been specially trained and are very important in making your summit to the highest free standing mountain on earth a success

Please see the breakdown on the recommended tipping amount note this is just a fair guideline and does not limit you to give more if you are happy with the services of your crew, again it all depends on the service level and most importantly your budget this guideline applies across all routes on Kilimanjaro.

Recommended Tipping Amount.

Head guide:	USD\$20 per day
Assistant guide/s:	USD\$12-15 per day
Cook:	USD\$12 per day
Porters:	USD\$5-8 per day
